

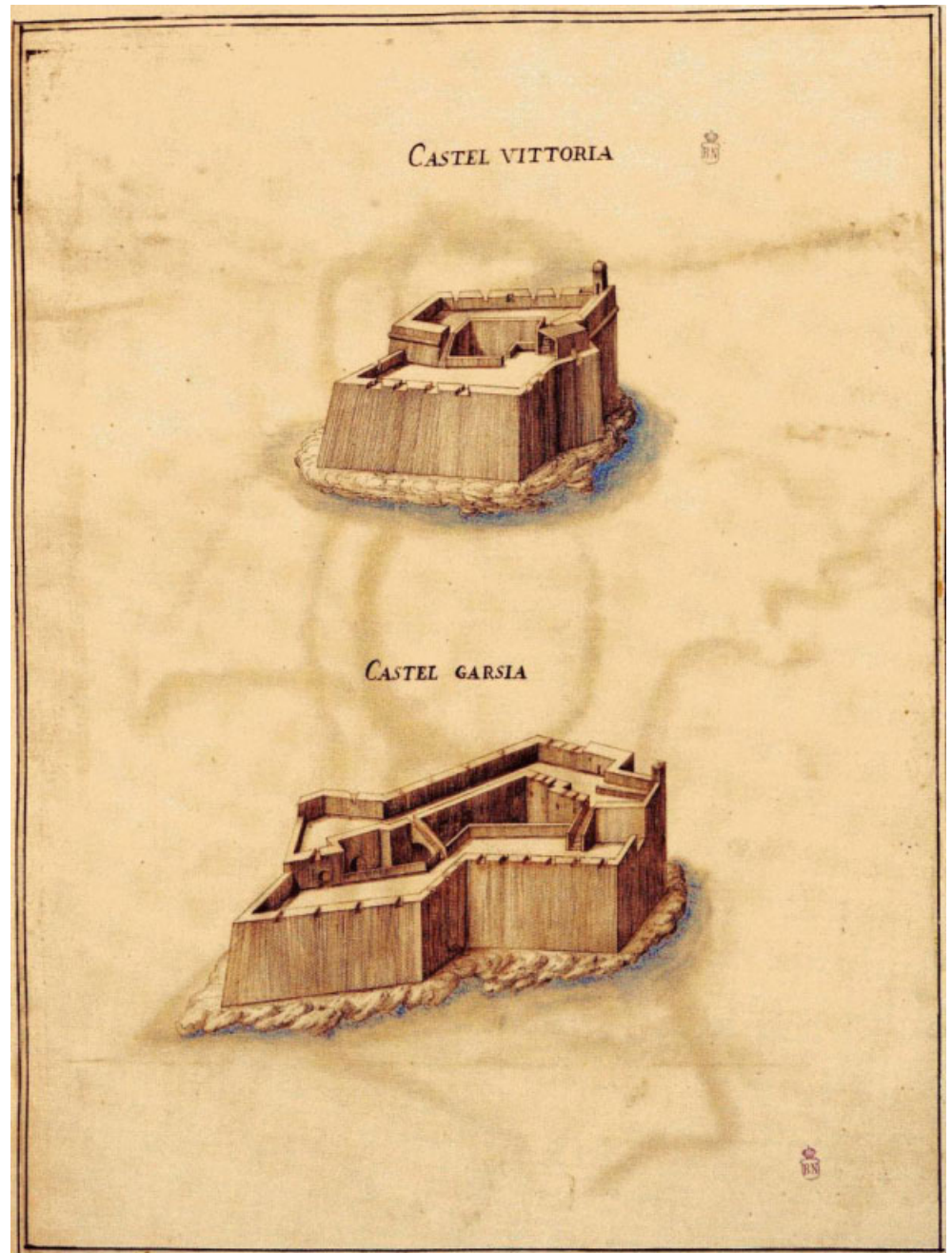

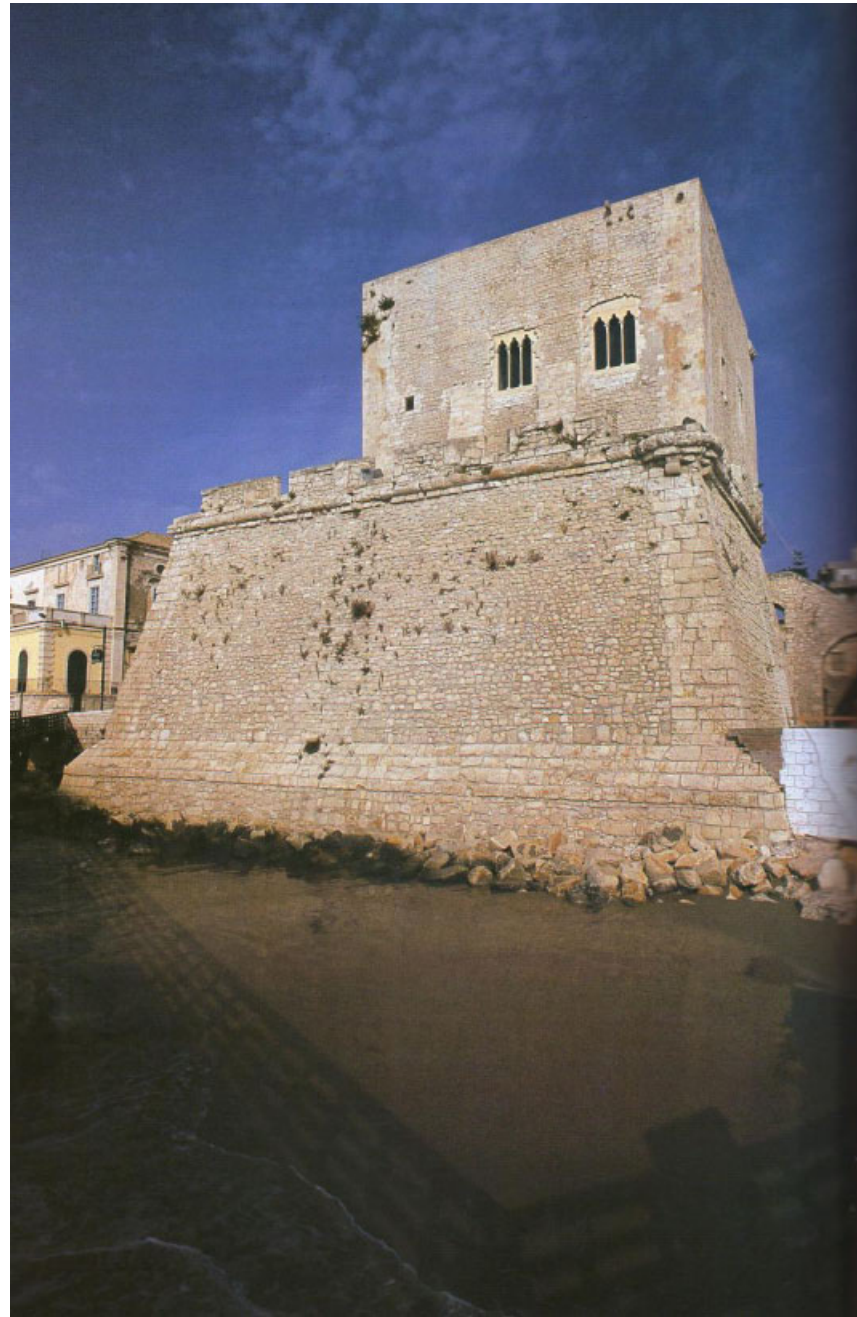

Plan of two Forts. (1640)



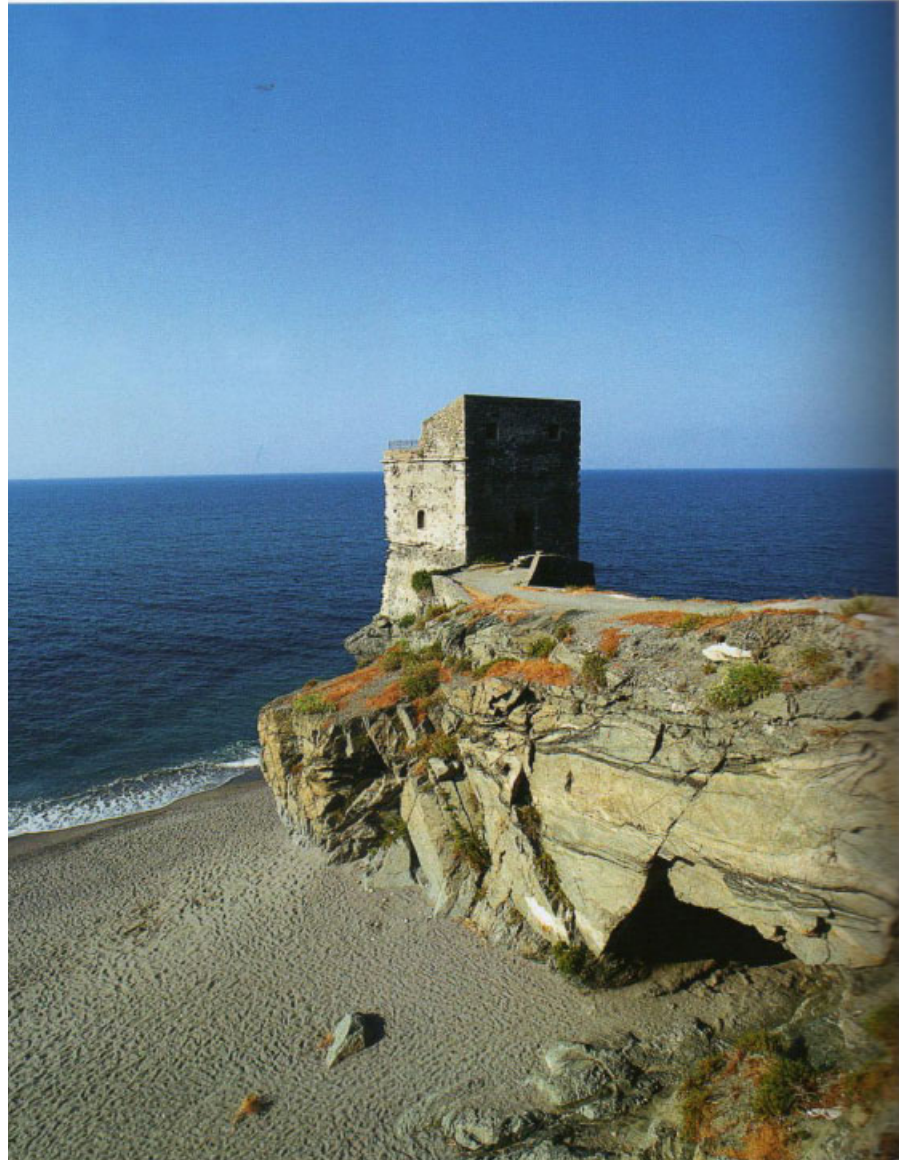

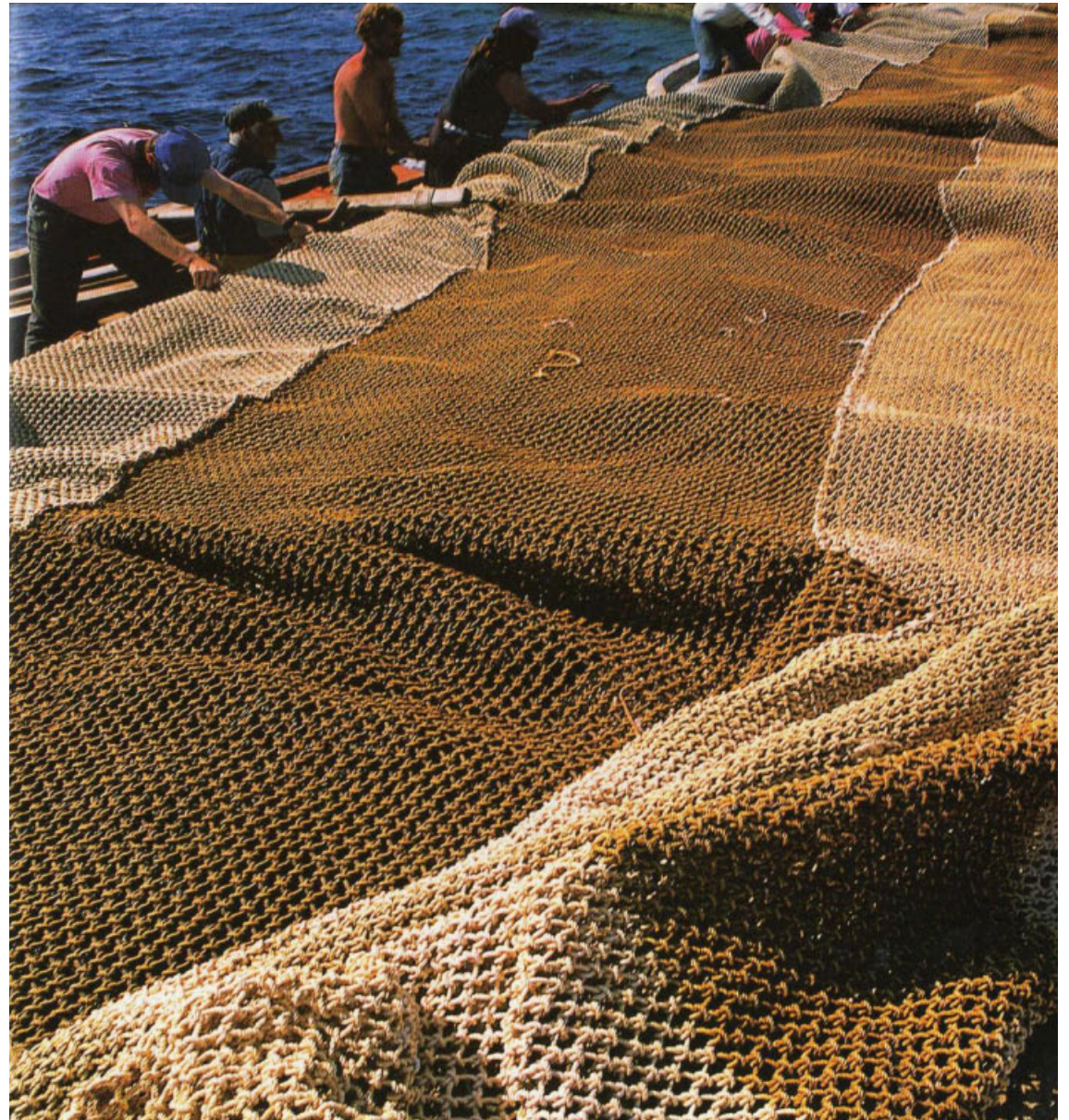

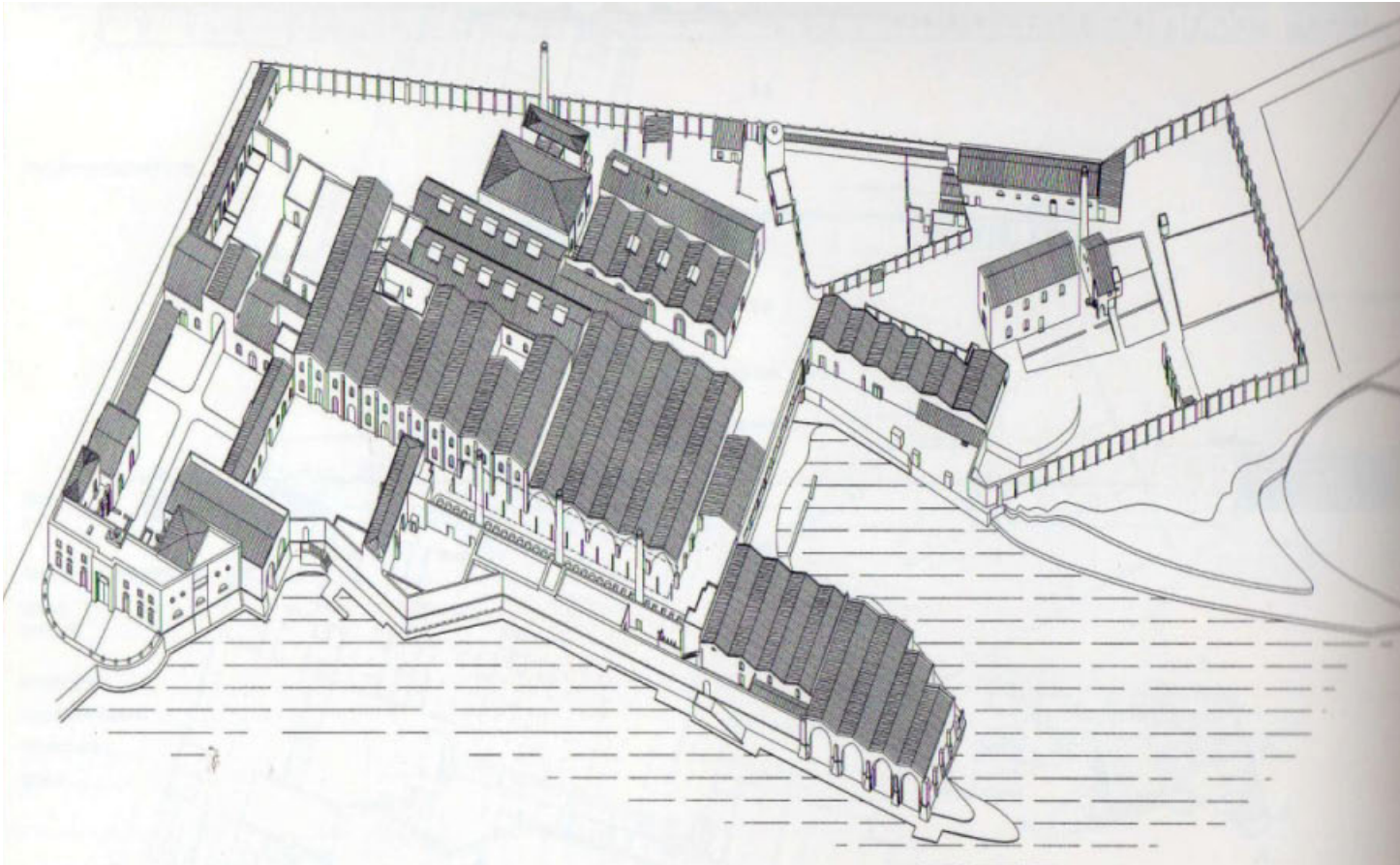


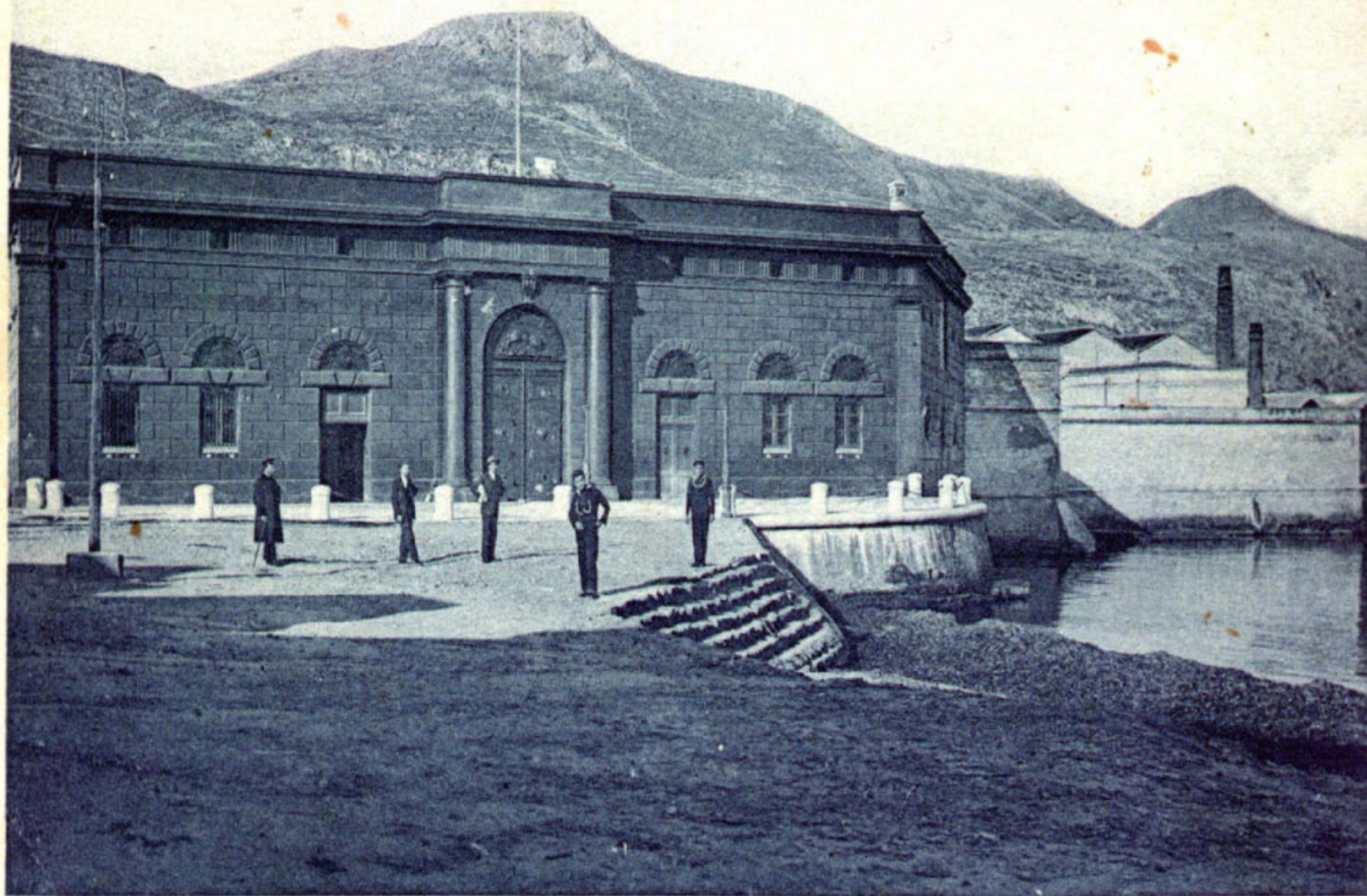

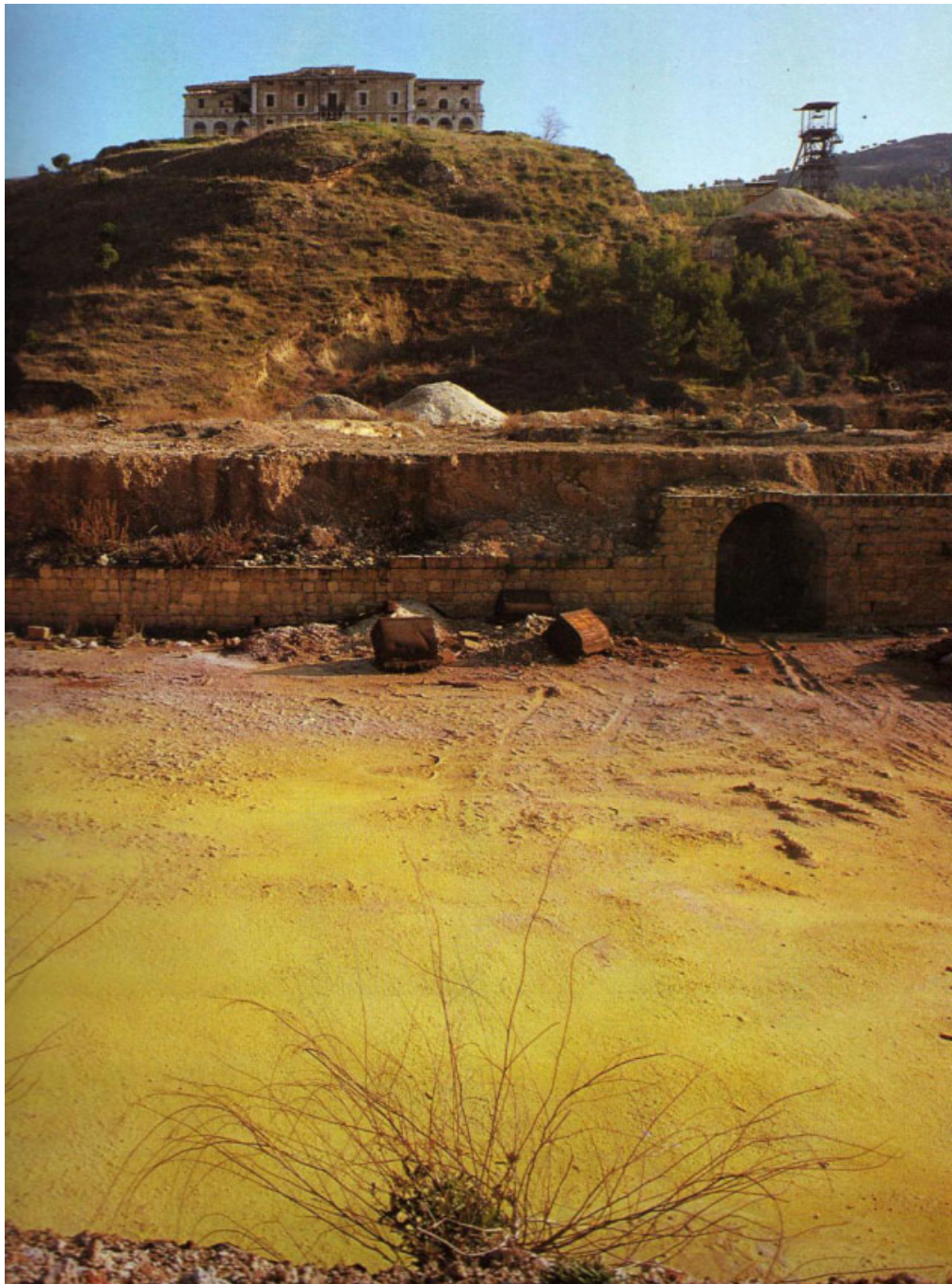

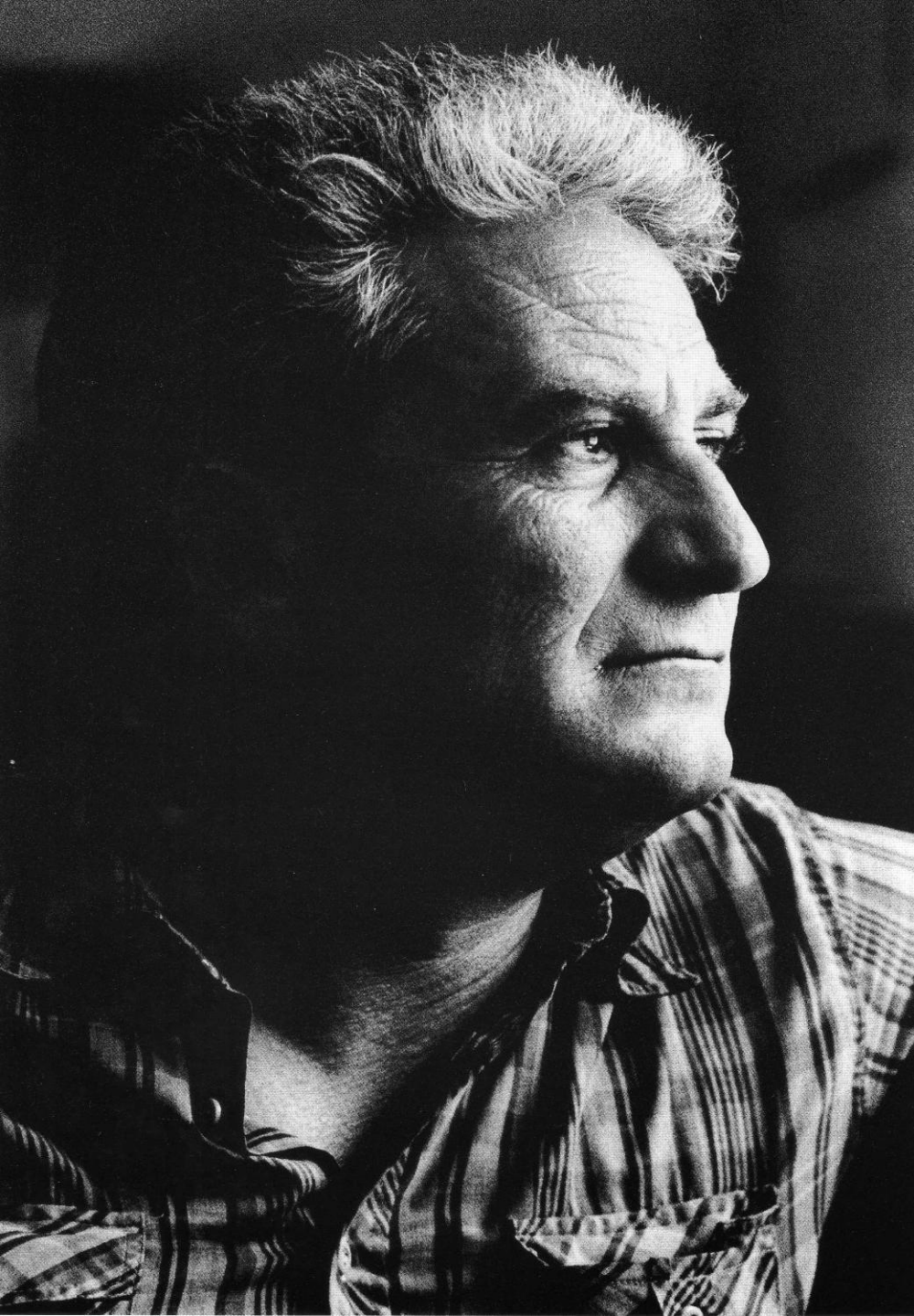

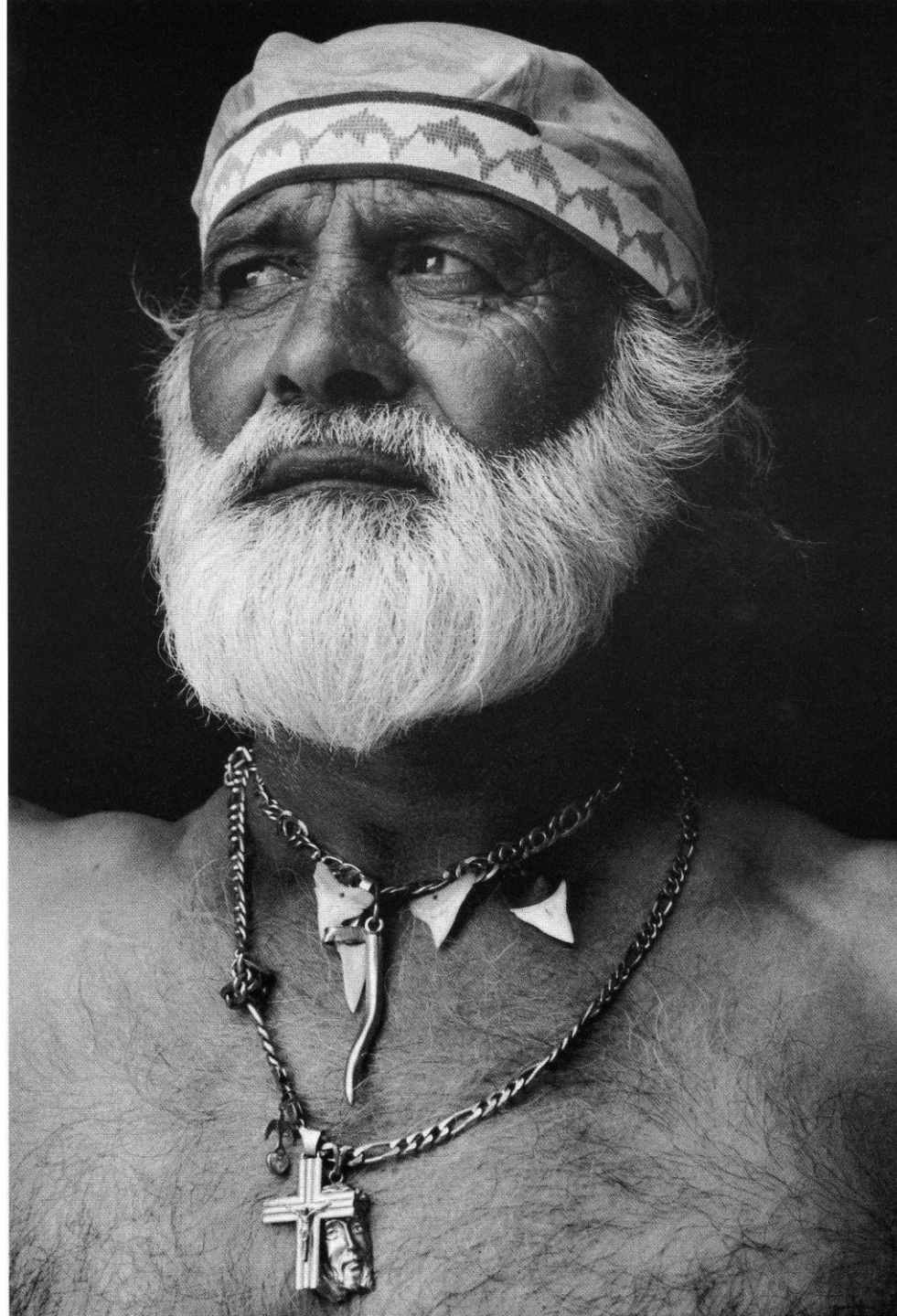

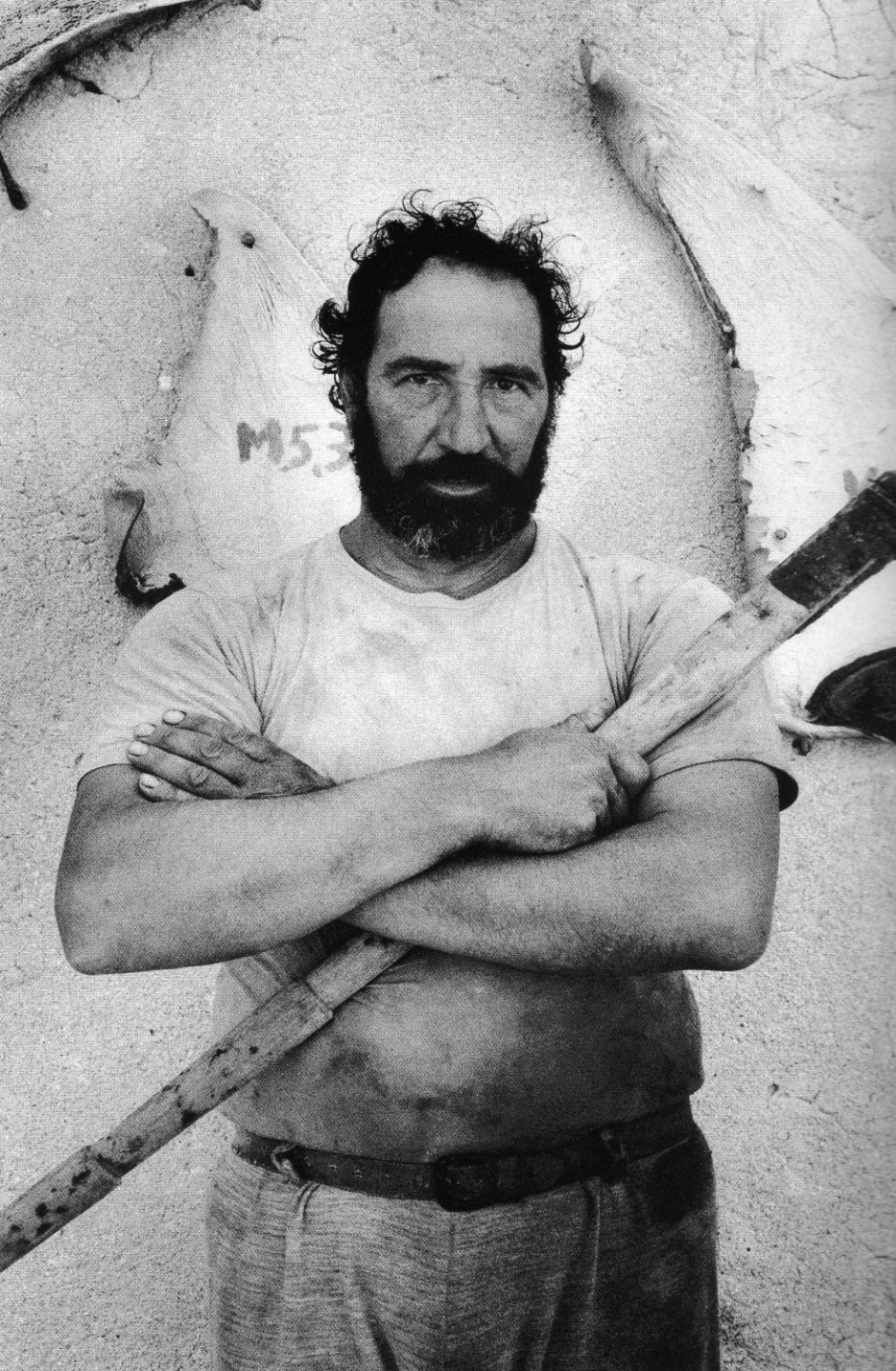
